What SBO can do for you!



- Advise and assist requirements generators/PMs/ PCOs
 - Assists in Market Research
 - Synopsis Coordination (RFI, Source Sought, Pre-Solicitation Notice, NOCA)
 - Acquisition Strategy Coordination (Acquisition Plans, Represents SBO at ASPs)
 - Clause/Provision and Source Selection Criteria
 - DD Form 2579 Coordination (Small Business Coordination Form)
 - Subcontracting plan review
 - And more!

Market Research



- Dynamic Small Business Search (www.ccr.gov)
 - SBA database of approximately 190,000 small businesses
 - Includes all SDB, 8(a), WOSB, VOSB, SDVOSB and HUBZones
- Collection of capability brochures
- Work with other SBOs to identify sources

DD Form 2579 and Subcontracting Plans



- Both must be completed and submitted electronically through EKM (<https://www.aekm.wpafb.af.mil>)
- Completed by CO/buyer



U.S. AIR FORCE

Subcontracting Plans



- Purpose
 - Describe the principal types of supplies and services to be subcontracted
- When are plans required?
 - For contract(s) or contract modification(s) that individually is expected to exceed \$550,000 (\$1,000,000 for construction) and that has subcontracting possibilities
- Get plans in early for review
- Plans are to be negotiated
- Comprehensive Small Business Subcontracting Plan
- SBO Provides review (not approval)

Early Involvement is Important!



- Involve the Small Business Office (SBO) early in the acquisition process
- SBO is here to help, not to be a roadblock

What is CAPS?



Consolidated Acquisition of Professional Services

- Program designed as a contract to provide Advisory & Assistance Services (A&AS) support to Aeronautical Systems Center (ASC) and Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB) tenant organizations.
- Organizations include Headquarters – Air Force Materiel Command (HQ AFMC), Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) and Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL).

What is CAPS?



- Supplements government organic resources with technical & management expertise in the acquisition of Air Force weapon systems.
- Wide range of acquisition disciplines and specialties available

What is CAPS?



- Consists of 9 Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contracts
- CAPS program ceiling is \$850M
- Ordering period extends to 19 Apr 2011
- Task orders are awarded using fair opportunity competitive procedures
 - All nine primes are afforded opportunity to compete
 - Award is made after technical evaluation
- Task order awards \$10M or greater can be protested to the Government Accountability Office (GAO)

CAPS II



- Successor effort to CAPS
- Designed to provide A&AS support to ASC and WPAFB tenant organizations
 - Anticipate greater level of support for AFMC and AFRL
 - Addition of 711 HPW A&AS requirements likely
 - Both will drive the addition of new labor categories
- Award date target: April 2011
- Early estimate of framework ceiling: \$3.0 Billion
